Smart Schools Investment Plan (SSIP)

In his 2014 State of the State Address, Governor Cuomo called for New York State to invest \$2 billion in its schools through a Smart Schools Bond Act – an initiative that would finance educational technology and infrastructure, providing students access to the latest technology and connectivity needed to succeed and compete in the global economy.

New Yorker's agreed and voted in the Smart Schools Bond Act (SSBA) in November 2014.

FPCS Smart School Investment Timeline

- September, 2015 – Approval of FPCS Technology Plan Survey
- February through April, 2016 – Stakeholder input and Smart Bond Investment Planning Meetings
- August, 2016 – Preliminary Plan Posted on District Website
- September 14, 2016 – Public Hearing and Board Approval
- September, 2016 – SED Submission/Approval of Spending as part of December Review Cycle

➤ FPCS Smart School Investment Spending Plan:

*Hardware Purchases –\$1,114,118

Technologies that will enhance instruction across all grade levels and classrooms

- 1:1 In-house devices
 - Chromebooks or laptops for JSHS classrooms
- Additional Laptop Carts
- iPad carts for Pre-K and Kindergarten classrooms
- Document cameras for all SMART enabled classrooms

Phase 1 Purchases – September, 2016

- Chromebooks for JSHS English and Social Studies classrooms
- Laptops for all teachers and for Science and Technology classrooms
- Additional Laptop Carts for 5th and 6th grade classrooms
- iPad carts for Pre-K and Kindergarten classrooms
- Document cameras for all SMART enabled classrooms
